OBJECTIVES

The most important questions we ask ourselves are: who are we, where do we come from and what are our values. The answer is closely connected to our relations with the villages that we originate from. We originate from the villages around the district of Navsari in India. Our people have migrated to all parts of the world from Canada to New Zealand. However, there remains a strong bond between us and the villages in India. The bond is related to the cultural connection with them. Many believe that once we break off this tie with the villages, our original culture will also be in free-fall. Where ever we settle in the world our culture develops, but once we forget our roots and the culture we brought with us a very important question arises: who have we become?

The Gammonati is a sub-committee of Amsuk, it meets only annually. The Gammonati was formed to support the Gam Mandals in the UK. In a roundabout way it exists to promote the welfare of the villages (gams) from which we originate. The objective is to discuss the work done by the gam mandals, what problems persist in the villages, how the mandals are identifying their role and how they help the villages. A key objective of our meeting is to learn from each other, see how the other gam mandals are implementing their strategy and ask ourselves if there is room for improvement in the way we run our own individual mandals.

The UK Gam Mandals are the final connection to our villages. The villages remain the birthplace of our culture and heritage. For decades this connection has been of paramount importance to protect our culture.

Last year we linked – up our village colleagues from a hotel in Surat to our Gammonati meeting in Leicester. The very successful international link-up was the first of its kind. We in Leicester discussed with the village reps all issues related to the villages. This year

 Time: In India 2.30pm in UK 10.30 am

- 4. The Association of Mandhata Samaj UK (AMSUK) has agreed to fund the event. The Gammonati is a sub-committee of Amsuk. The members of the Gammonati committee are very grateful to Amsuk for this visionary funding.
- 5. The event this year is much bigger than last year. As there will be a General Meeting of all the reps in the villages, each Gam will be represented by larger numbers than last year. The International Gammonati Conference will therefore be conducted with a team of representatives from each Gam in India with a team of representatives from the UK Gam Mandals.
- 6. PLEASE ENSURE YOUR UK GAM MANDAL IS WELL REPRESENTED AT THE GAMMONATI MEETING IN LEICESTER.
- 7. The whole event, the General Meeting in Navsari and Gammonati Conference, will be covered and presented at the Leicester Hall on a large screen and speakers beginning at 4.30am UK time. The Gammonati Conference will begin at 10am UK time. Please come as early as possible to participate in both events.
